

- suitable location of our region




Jan Sudek



- born in 1896 in Kolin on the Labe, died in 1976 in Prague
- loses his arm in WW1, Italian front
- in 1932 held first exhibition in Prague
- a lot of portraits, still-lives, landscapes and architecture
- respected for poetic, romantic, deep emotions and crystal-clearness in his art.





František Drtikol


- born in 1883 in Příbram, died in 1961 in Prague, as a photographer totally forgotten

- then he started painting and studying eastern philosophy





Jan Reich




- born in Prague in 1942
